

Complete Immersion in the Islands - Land excursions - 12 days/11 nights

Full itinerary

Day 1 - Baltra / Isabela - Arrival

AM

- Arrival of travelers at Seymour - Baltra Airport on the Galapagos Islands;
- All visitors must pay Galápagos National Park entrance fees upon arrival. Arrange for payment of 200 USD in cash (price subject to change without notice);
- After collecting your luggage, transport awaits you for the transfer to Isabela Island. Transportation includes bus, boat and taxi to Puerto Ayora port. A speedboat eventually takes you to Isabela Island;

PM

- Taxi transfer to the hotel in Puerto Villamil;
- Late lunch to be expected in Puerto Villamil (not included);
- You can take advantage of the end of the day to rest or enjoy the city and the beach;
- Dinner in a restaurant in Puerto Villamil (not included);
- Night in 3-star accommodation – Puerto Villamil.

Day 2 - Isabela

Isabela Island is surrounded by magnificent terrestrial and marine flora and fauna that are not possible to observe on the other islands. Among other things, it is possible to observe penguins (the smallest in the world), cormorants and pink flamingos.

This day allows you to discover the volcanic formations forming the islands in addition to snorkeling with different marine species such as sharks, sea lions, turtles and much more!

AM

- Breakfast at the hotel and departure for the day around 8:00;
- Transfer to the port;
- Light hiking in the spectacular volcanic rock formations and snorkeling (snorkeling equipment provided on request);
- A lunch is served during the activity;

PM

- Return to Puerto Villamil mid-afternoon;
- Free time in the afternoon;
- Dinner in a restaurant in Puerto Villamil (not included);
- Night in 3-star accommodation – Puerto Villamil.

Day 3 - Isabela

Isabela Island is the largest island in the archipelago, but is sparsely populated. Its population is mainly concentrated in the southern part of the island, in the town of Puerto Villamil. Isabela is a still active volcanic island, with a chain of 5 young active volcanoes. Several species of tortoises and birds can be seen there.

During this day, you will have the opportunity to hike and/or horseback ride in the spectacular landscapes of Isabela. You will have the opportunity to visit the south-central part of the island and climb the Sierra Negra volcano with an altitude of around 1124m, from where you will have a breathtaking view of a large part of this vast island. It is the 2nd largest volcano crater in the world with a diameter of 10 km.

- Breakfast at the hotel and departure for the day around 8:00;
- A lunch is served during the activity;
- Return to the hotel at the end of the day;
- Dinner in a restaurant in Puerto Villamil (not included);
- Night in 3-star accommodation – Puerto Villamil.

Day 4 - Isabela

Accompanied by your naturalist guide, you will explore completely different landscapes and learn more about the history of the island and the programs to protect animal species. This will be your last chance to learn everything about Isabela Island!

AM

- Breakfast at the hotel and departure for the day's activity around 8:00;
- Light hike in the national park trails and visit to the turtle protection center;
- Bike ride to the Wall of Tears (am or pm, depending on time);

PM

- Early afternoon, return to town to Puerto Villamil for lunch in a local restaurant (not included);
- Return to the hotel and free time in the afternoon;
- Dinner in a restaurant in Puerto Villamil (not included);
- Night in 3-star accommodation – Puerto Villamil.

Day 5 - Isabela / Santa Cruz

AM

- Breakfast at the hotel and early departure for the port of Puerto Villamil to take the ferry (speed boat) towards the island of Santa Cruz
- Arrival mid-morning in Puerto Ayora, Santa Cruz;
- Transfer to the hotel and taking possession of the rooms;
- Lunch in a restaurant in Puerto Ayora (not included);

PM

- Bay tour in the afternoon;
- Dinner in a restaurant in Puerto Ayora (not included);

- Night in 3-star accommodation – Puerto Ayora.

Day 6 - Santa Fé

AM

- Breakfast at the hotel and departure for the day around 8:00;
- The boat crossing to Santa Fe Island takes approximately 1 hour;

Santa Fe is a small uninhabited island located southeast of Santa Cruz. During this day, you can snorkel with sea lions, observe native land iguanas and discover the flora and fauna unique to this island. If you've ever dreamed of snorkeling among sea lions, Santa Fe will impress you!

- A lunch is served during the activity;

PM

- Return to Puerto Ayora at the end of the afternoon;
- Return to the hotel and free time for the end of the day;
- Dinner in a restaurant in Puerto Ayora (not included);
- Night in 3-star accommodation – Puerto Ayora.

Day 7 - Santa Cruz

The island of Santa Cruz is located in the center of the archipelago and is the heart of its administrative and tourist activity. It is the second largest island in the Galapagos and above all the most populated. This day will allow you to visit several attractions on the island and see the different landscapes found there.

AM

- Breakfast at the hotel and departure for the day around 8:00;
- Transport to the center of the island in the highlands;
- You will do light hiking to discover the fauna and flora specific to this region and, among other things, observe the giant tortoises in their natural habitat;

PM

- Dinner in the ranch (included);
- Visit the magnificent Tortuga Bay beach, considered one of the 25 most beautiful beaches in the world;
- Return to the hotel and free time for the end of the day;
- Dinner in a restaurant in Puerto Ayora (not included);
- Night in 3-star accommodation – Puerto Ayora.

Day 8 - Bartholomé or North Seymour

AM

- Breakfast at the hotel and departure for the day around 7:00;
- Land transfer to the Itabaca Canal and navigation towards Bartolomé;

Bartolomé is a small island offering an extraordinary landscape. Its viewpoint allows you to have a breathtaking view of the surrounding volcanic formations. The activity includes a portion of land hiking and a portion of freediving allowing you to observe turtles, penguins and small reef sharks.

North Seymour is an uninhabited island which is home to nearly 2500 land iguanas. It is one of the best places to observe them in the wild. You can also observe large colonies of frigatebirds and blue footed boobies, as well as sea lions and marine iguanas. You would be able to walk around all this incredible fauna during this day.

- A lunch is served during the activity;

PM

- Return to Puerto Ayora at the end of the afternoon;
- Return to the hotel and free time for the end of the day;
- Dinner in a restaurant in Puerto Ayora (not included);
- Night in 3-star accommodation – Puerto Ayora.

Day 9 - Santa Cruz / San Cristobal

AM

- Breakfast at the hotel and early departure for the port of Puerto Ayora to take the ferry to the island of San Cristóbal;
- Arrival mid-morning in Puerto Baquerizo Moreno, San Cristóbal;

San Cristóbal is recognized by Ecuadorians as the capital of happiness! Its welcoming village atmosphere will charm you from the moment you arrive.

- Transfer to the hotel and taking possession of the rooms;
- Lunch in a restaurant in Puerto Baquerizo Moreno (not included);

PM

- Visit around the city, interpretation center and tijeretas;
- Dinner in a restaurant in Puerto Baquerizo Moreno (not included);
- Night in 3-star accommodation – Puerto Baquerizo Moreno, San Cristóbal.

Day 10 - San Cristóbal

AM

- Breakfast at the hotel and departure for the day around 8:00;

- A journey of approximately 40 minutes by boat awaits you to reach the site of León Dormido (Kicker rock);

León Dormido is a site located west of San Cristóbal. The rock gets its name from the fact that, from a certain angle, it looks like a sleeping lion. The site is made up of 2 giant monoliths, which offer wall snorkeling where it is possible to observe large pelagics, schools of fish and sharks, sea turtles and much more!

- A lunch is served during the activity;

PM

- Stop on a beach on the way back (place to be determined depending on the places authorized by the National Park);
- Return to Puerto Baquerizo Moreno late in the afternoon;
- Return to the hotel and free time in the afternoon;
- Dinner in a restaurant in Puerto Baquerizo Moreno (not included);
- Night in 3-star accommodation – Puerto Baquerizo Moreno.

Day 11 - San Cristóbal

AM

- Breakfast at the hotel and departure for the day around 8:00;
- Boat trip to reach the Punta Pitt site;

The Punta Pitt site is at the northeastern tip of the island of San Cristóbal. This is the only place in the archipelago where it is possible to observe the 3 species of gannets present in the Galapagos. The freediving site is located along an eroded rock. It is possible to observe different pelagics, turtles, etc. there. After freediving, you will also have time to explore the magnificent land portion of Punta Pitt to observe the bird colonies.

- A lunch is served during the activity;

PM

- Return to the hotel at the end of the afternoon and free time at the end of the day;
- Dinner in a restaurant in Puerto Baquerizo Moreno (not included);
- Night in 3-star accommodation – Puerto Baquerizo Moreno.

Day 12 - San Cristóbal - Departure

AM

- Breakfast serve at the hotel and luggage preparation;
- You will have the opportunity to enjoy the town of Puerto Baquerizo Moreno one last time before noon before taking the plane to Quito in the early afternoon;
- Transfer to the airport;

PM

- Return flight to Quito/Guayaquil*.

*Not included, we can help you book international and domestic flights to the Galapagos.

INCLUSIONS

- 10 full days of land excursions;
- Transport between the island of Baltra to the port of Puerto Ayora (inter-island transport by plane also possible on request, additional costs to be expected);
- 3 boat transfers between the islands of Isabela, Santa Cruz and San Cristóbal;
- All land transfers mentioned in the itinerary;
- 11 nights of accommodation on the Galapagos Islands in 3-star category;
- 11 breakfasts and 8 lunches (19 meals);
- Excursions mentioned in the itinerary;
- English-speaking/Spanish-speaking guide at destination;
- Galápagos National Park naturalist guide for land excursions;

- All international and domestic flights not mentioned;
- Other land transportation not mentioned;
- INGALA Migration card 20 USD (airport)*;
